UCDVO statement on Palestine

18 September 2024

As a charity that is based in University College Dublin', UCDVO welcomes the statement by UCD¹ (8 June 2024): "UCD is a university with a strong commitment to human rights and the rule of law. Accordingly, we are outraged by the ongoing mass killing of civilians, the withholding of humanitarian aid, and the destruction in Palestine by Israel. As a member of the global university community with an enduring commitment to academic freedom, expression and safety, UCD is particularly appalled by the destruction of all universities in Gaza and attacks on their students, faculty and staff."

UCDVO particularly welcomes UCD's recognition of "the powerful tradition of student and staff activism in our university, as in others, in bringing about positive change". Given UCDVO's vision is of a vibrant, global community working together for a fair and sustainable world, we salute the students who participated in the (largely peaceful) UCD encampment, for their expression of solidarity with the Palestinian people, and commitment to human rights and justice.

UCDVO condemns all killing of civilians and breaches of international law, including the Hamas attacks on 7 October 2023 that killed over 1,200 Israelis (including foreign nationals)².

UCDVO is horrified at the ongoing catastrophe in Gaza. The humanitarian impact of Israel's bombardment and siege of Gaza is staggering. According to the latest UNOCHA reports³, over 41,000 Palestinians have been killed; over 94,000 reported injured, 1.9 million Palestinians are displaced.

The World Food Programme (Situation Report 26)⁴, reports that almost the entire population of Gaza is food insecure. In the words of Philippe Lazarini, UNRWA Commissioner General on 12 July⁵, "Gaza is decimated. More than two million people are trapped in a living hell.
